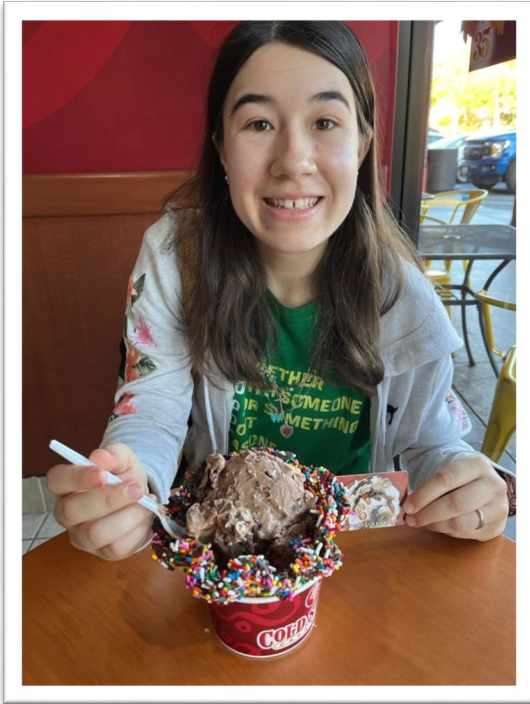


Dear Families,
