Job Purpose

The Program Leader provides recreation, education, job training, and paid work on-site and in the community for adults with developmental disabilities employed at WineBev Services located at 500 Technology Way, Napa, CA 94558. WineBev Services packages wine and provides work crews for wine and hospitality industry related businesses.

Wages and Benefits

\$13 per hour after 90-Day Probationary Period: \$12.50 per hour to start.

Medical and Dental Coverage: \$450 monthly allowance in addition to monthly wages.

Medical Allowance: Adds \$2.60 per hour in compensation to your base hourly wage.

Retirement Plan: 403b plan self-contributions are matched up to 5% after one year.

Kaiser Health Plan and Principal Dental: Offered through UCP of the North Bay.

Paid Time Off: Employees working 30+ hours per week earn up to 15 days annually.

Paid Transportation: Employees driving vans have no-cost commute to and from work.

Birthday Bonus: \$50 for full-time (30+ hours) employees to celebrate your birthday.

Career Advancement: Opportunities in both direct service and supervisory career tracks.
